



## **ZOOMA Half Marathon & 5K Running Event Notice**

Dear Resident,

The Zooma Women's Half Marathon & 5K, is scheduled to run through the Pope Bend Rd., Old Highway 71 and River Crossing neighborhoods on Saturday, April 4, 2009. This event benefits Lifeworks, Inc., a local non-profit serving Central Texas children and families

The start and finish of the race are at on the grounds of the Hyatt Lost Pines. Traffic control has been closely coordinated with the Bastrop County Sheriff's Department, The Texas Department of Transportation and our traffic control coordinator to ensure that access to the community is not infringed. However, during the peak hours of 7:45 a.m. and 9:30 a.m., motorists on Pope Bend Road and Old Highway 71 may encounter temporary traffic delays along the route.

Your patience is appreciated.

### **A few important things to keep in mind:**

- **All road ways will be open to motor vehicles while the race is in progress. There are no total closures in effect. Please drive with caution.**
- **Lane reductions will be in effect on the West side of Pope Bend Road, however motor vehicle access will be preserved.**
- **Bastrop County Sheriffs will be on location at major intersections to direct traffic.**
- **All runners will be off the roadway no later than 11:30 a.m.**
- **Emergency vehicle access will remain open all day and will not be impeded by this event.**
